

Military Spouse Appreciation Scholarship MSAS

Spouses of active duty service members stationed at Camp Lejeune and Marine Corps Air Station are eligible for Campbell University's Military Spouse Appreciation Scholarship. These tuition benefits apply to undergraduate studies at Campbell University's campuses at Camp LeJeune and Marine Corp Air Station, New River.

The purpose of this pilot program is to recognize the sacrifices made by military spouses during the war on terror in Afghanistan and Iraq and is designed to military spouses complete a bachelors degree with Campbell University.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. The student must be enrolled for 6 or more semester hours each term or for a combination of at least 12 semester hours each semester at the Camp LeJeune and/or Marine Corp Air Station, New River campuses of Campbell University.
2. The student must apply for all available financial aid, excluding loans, which will be applied to the cost of their tuition before the University benefits apply.
3. The student must provide documentation to show that s/he is the spouse of an active duty service member.
4. Students must maintain a Cumulative Grade Point Average of 2.0 or better to continue participation in this scholarship program.

Exclusions:

1. The MSAS program is not available to students who are themselves active duty service members.
2. The MSAS program excludes distance education/internet courses.
3. Laboratory or other special fees are not covered by this program.
4. Campbell University reserves the right to discontinue this program at any time or to limit the number of recipients during any given semester or academic year.
