Military families with children who have developmental disabilities enrolled in the Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP) at Camp Lejeune will be eligible for services through the Strengthening Military Families Project (SMFP) provided through the Family Support Program at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and the staff of the Family Support Network of the Crystal Coast (FSN-CC).

Services Available to all military families referred by the EFMP Case Managers. Military families who do not qualify for (or agree to) intensive services through the SMFP are still eligible to participate in all Family Support Network of the Crystal Coast activities, including:

- Information and referral
- Parent-to-Parent Support
- Sibling Workshops
- Social Activities
- Informational/training Workshops
