Sample Questions for Childcare Provider Interview

What are your credentials/experiences/training? What type of training (CPR, first aid) do you have?

What is the toughest situation you have had with a child? Tell me about a time when you faced a crisis on the job. How did you handle it?

Why have you chosen to work as a Respite care provider? What do you think is the most challenging part of caregiving?

As a caregiver for children, what types of special needs do you have experience working with?

Would you tell me if my child or children became too much for you to handle?

Are you flexible with times you are available to provide respite care?

What would be your proudest moment in caregiving? Why?

Do you have a good contact number/cell phone that I can reach you at for scheduling or emergency purposes?

Comfort level with behavior issues (screaming, tantrums, running, etc.), working with more than one special needs child at a time, smoking, pets, allergies, etc.

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
