

## Fencing Classes/Open Fencing

Location: H.I.T.T. Center (formerly Area 4 Gymnasium)

Dates/Times: Classes held on Fridays. Eight-week sessions begin:  
8 Apr • 10 Jun • 12 Aug • 14 Oct

Intermediate Class: 1730-Closing

Beginner Class: 1830-1945

Open Fencing: 1730-Closing

Beginner Class: No experience necessary

\$40 (all equipment provided)

Learn foil fencing from the ground up, including footwork, blade work, strategy, rules, competition. Students should wear loose-fitting clothing and athletic shoes.

Intermediate Class: Beginner class or equivalent experience required.

\$40 (all equipment provided)

Class tailored to individual students and competition. Épée and sabre may be introduced.

Open Fencing: Previous fencing experience required.

\$5 per night (equipment can be provided)

Fencing will be primarily electric foil and épée. Sabre will probably be dry at the present time.

Instructor: Classes are instructed by Greg Spahr, Head Coach of the Cape Fear Fencing Association, former coach of the Johns Hopkins University Women's Team, and moniteur in all weapons through the Academie d'Armes Internationale. His students have won national collegiate titles, North Carolina Fencing League High School Championships, and finished as high as 5<sup>th</sup> in the United States Fencing Association Championships.

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
