COURSES

Paradise Point Golf Course is conveniently located just inside the main gate at Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune, North Carolina. Paradise Point Golf Course offers a truly memorable experience featuring two 18-hole courses, a stately clubhouse, and an extensive Pro Shop.

The 18-hole "Gold" course stretches 7,040 yards from the Blue championship tees, has a course rating/slope of 74.2/129, and a par of 72. Opened in 1943, the course was designed by Scottish designer Fred Finlay with help from George Cobb, a world renowned golf course architect, while he was a Marine stationed at Camp Lejeune.

The 18-hole "Scarlet," built shortly after the Gold course, features 5,911 yards, with a course rating/slope of 67.7/114, and a Par of 70.

The expansive practice facilities offer two driving ranges (including one with 20 covered bays), three practice greens, two practice bunkers, and a members' practice range.

TOURNAMENT PACKAGES

A course may be reserved for your group with a minimum of 48 players at least 7 days in advance.

All tournament packages include golf carts, greens fees, and a scorekeeper.

A selection of meals is available. Tournament menus start at \$5 per player and include a variety of meals. Pricing is based on menu items requested.

BRUCE OLIVER, MPGA

- Bruce Oliver entered the golf industry in 1968 and has been a member of the Professional Golfers Association since 1972. He received his Master Professional Golf Association (MPGA) designation in 1992. There are currently only 323 MPGAs in the United States.

GRANT BECK, PGA

- Grant Beck served as the Installation Sergeant Major, the highest ranking Enlisted Marine at Camp Lejeune, from August 1987 to his retirement in 1989. Upon retirement from the Marine Corps, Grant eased into the golf business and in 1998 added the "Class A" PGA designation to his numerous list of achievements.

Together these two professionals run tournaments, organize clinics, and conduct personal and group lessons to golfers of all levels – from beginners to local pros.



Paradise Point Clubhouse features a spacious meeting room, Duffers Retreat snack bar, and a Pro Shop featuring products from the industry leaders in golf apparel and equipment.



Eagles' Nest meeting room, with a capacity for 75 people, is available upstairs in the Clubhouse for meetings and banquets.



COBB PAVILION is covered (with a capacity of 150 people), and is a perfect setting for group events. \$50 usage fee is waived for all tournaments.
